The assessment will cover Reading, Written Expression, Math, Science, Social Studies, Vocabulary, Spelling, Capitalization, Punctuation, and Math Computations. The test is broken up into three days and each day a student will take one or more of the topics listed above.

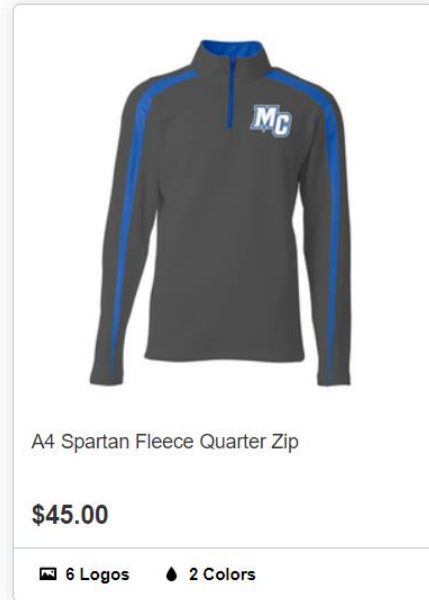

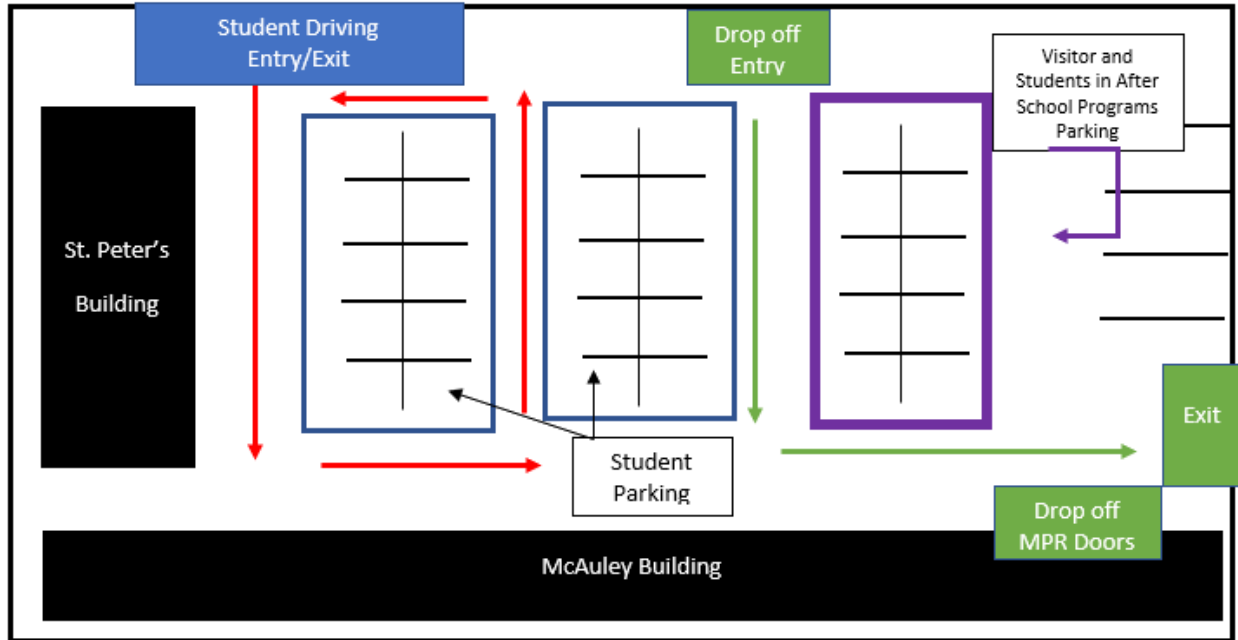
FACTS and Teacher Emails
