- Once completed (with a parent signature) return this paper to the school office. It can be dropped off or emailed to Mr. Cook at dcook@jacschools.org. Forms will be accepted up to Friday, October 15th at 3:00 PM.
- We will schedule students on a first come basis.
- If the form is not returned, the student will be automatically enrolled in their elective classes for Quarter 2.
- Due to course offerings and class sizes, all requests will be considered but may not be able to be granted.
