

St. Mary's Summer School Basics

- Classes are available for ALL area Children from 2-year olds to current 5th grade students, depending on each class's descriptions. Students are placed in classes on a first come, first served basis.
- Registration and tuition <u>must</u> be paid prior to or on the first day of class. Payments may be made with cash or check. Your prompt payment holds your child's enrollment in his or her class/classes.
- Summer school classes have a **one-time \$15** registration fee (for one class session or several) and each class is priced at \$80 per week. Each student will receive a snazzy St. Mary's Summer School t-shirt with their registration.
- Students should be registered for the class/grade he or she will attend in the fall. Rising 1st graders, for example, should enroll in classes for the incoming Kindergarten 2nd grade students.
- For K-2nd and 3rd-6th grade students who may be attending both morning and afternoon classes the weeks of June 7-10 and/or June 14-17, please bring a sack lunch and drink each day.
- Cancellations must be made at least five days prior to the start of the class. After that time, cancellations will result in forfeiture of payment except in cases of illness (with doctor's note), or a family emergency.

Preschool Summer School Classes

St. Mary's Preschool summer classes are open to children in two different groups, an Early Learners (incoming 2 year olds) class and a combined Advanced Learners (incoming 3 year olds) and Pre-Kindergarten (incoming 4 year olds) class. Early Learners do not need to be potty-trained to attend, but must wear a pull-up to school. Advanced Learners and Pre-K students must be potty-trained in order to attend.

Preschool summer classes will be taught from 9:00 a.m. to Noon, Monday through Thursday. Class size is limited to 8 students for Early Learners and 15 students for the combined Advanced Learners and Pre-K classes to allow for plenty of individualized attention and fun, so register early so your child doesn't miss out on the fun! A snack and drink will be provided each day. Please let the school know if your child has any dietary restrictions or concerns.

Preschool students should be walked into school using the Preschool Entrance and picked up at noon from their classroom door. Elementary students should be walked into the school for drop-off and picked up from the Commons at noon or 4:00 p.m. dismissal. Please make every effort to pick your child up promptly at their dismissal time. Doors will release at 8:50 a.m. each morning for drop-off.

During the weeks of June $7^{th} - 10^{th}$ and June $14^{th} - 17^{th}$, incoming Kindergarten – 6^{th} graders have the option of attending both morning and afternoon Summer Fun classes. If your child would like to attend morning and afternoon sessions, they will have lunch each afternoon with Mrs. Lown. Please ensure that your child comes to summer school each morning with a sack lunch and drink. We will eat lunch as a group in the Cafeteria and enjoy some time together before afternoon classes begin at 1:00 p.m.

St. Mary' has all kinds of fun planned for your child this summer! Class size is capped at 15 students in most classes, so register early!
